supplies

Fabric Requirements:

- Size 2/3 to 4/5: ½ yd.
- Size 6/7: ⅔ yd.

treasure pocket pants

page 75

assemble the pocketed side panels

- 4 WRONG sides together, line up the stitching, line markings you transferred from the pattern pieces, then pin in place and stitch along the marked stitching line.

page 76

make contrast waist facing

- 16 Measure the waist opening and cut a contrast waist facing 2½" wide x the length measured plus ¾".

the to-go artist

page 103

cut the fabric

Piece 2: 10¼" x 13¼" (Left Panel)

- Cut 1 Fabric B
- Cut 1 Fabric C

create the left panel

- 2 With RIGHT sides together, place the long raw edge of Piece 5, 6" from the top raw edge of Piece 2 fabric B (being careful to place Piece 5 evenly across Piece 2), pin and stitch together ¼" from the raw edge.

page 105

- 13 With RIGHT sides together Stitch Piece 2 (Fabrics B and C) along the long raw edge on the RIGHT side. Flip the piece WRONG sides together, press flat, and edgestitch along the folded edge. Set aside.

create the right panel

- 15 Turn the top raw edges ¼" and press flat, turn again ¼" and press flat. Topstitch the turned edge.

finish the to-go-artist

- 17 Place Piece 2 on the left half of Piece 1 (Fabric B) with WRONG side facing the RIGHT side. Align the raw edges, and pin in place.
- 18 Place Piece 4 on top of the left half of Piece 1 (Fabric B) with WRONG side facing the RIGHT side. Align the raw edges, and pin in place.
- 23 In the middle of the right side of Piece 4, place the WRONG side (Velcro side) of the tab facing the RIGHT side of Piece 4. Stitch in place with the raw edges aligned.

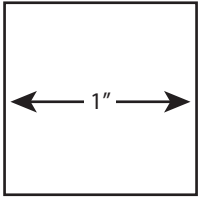
Zipper Panel: Cut 2 in main fabric, cut 2 in lining fabric, and cut 2 in flannel.
